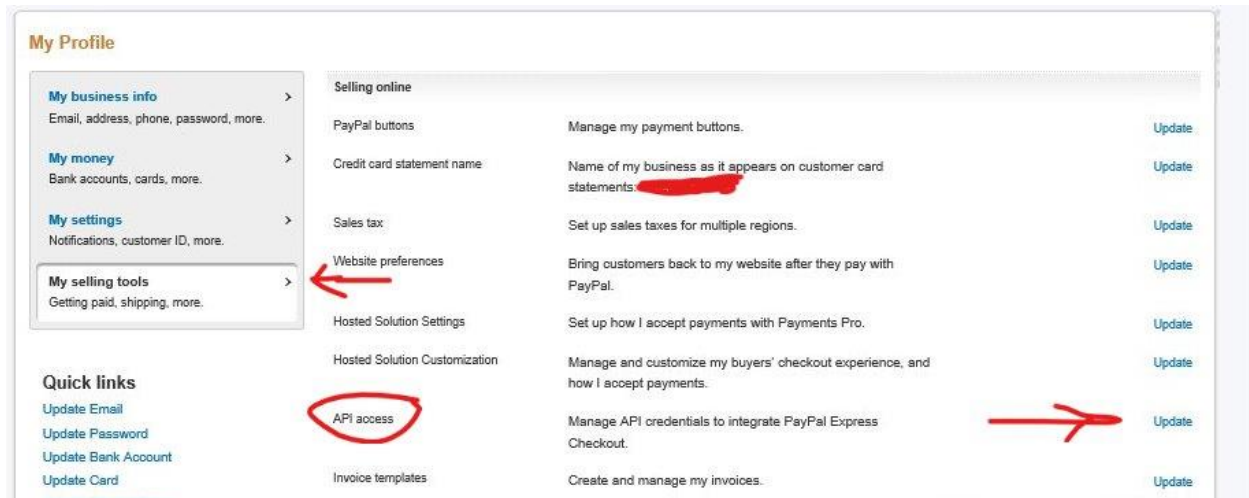
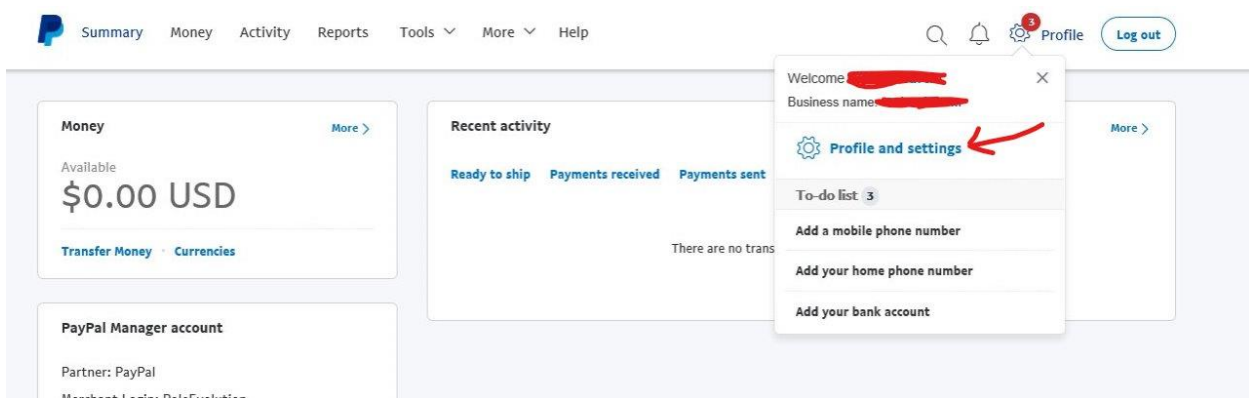
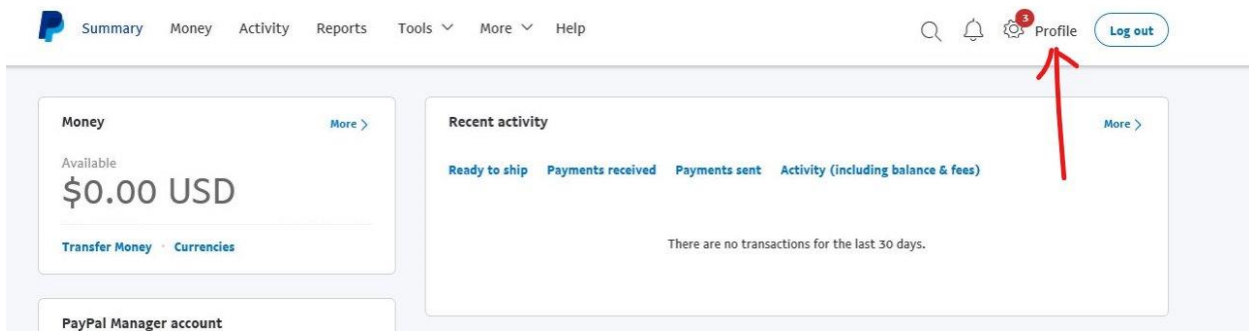

## Your payment API credentials

To accept PayPal payments on your website, you or your developer will need API credentials. The API (Application Programming Interface) allows PayPal to communicate with your online store or shopping cart.

## How is PayPal set up on your website?



### PayPal API

#### Through a shopping cart provider

##### Pre-built payment solution

If you're using or plan to use a 3rd-party platform, like Magento or Shopify, for shopping carts and online stores where the PayPal payment processor is built in.

#### Custom checkout experience

##### Braintree SDK integration

The Braintree SDK is powered by Braintree, a PayPal service. These easy to integrate SDKs allow you to accept payments via PayPal on your website and native mobile apps.

##### NVP/SOAP API integration (Classic)

You or your developer integrated NVP/SOAP (or "Classic") APIs that allow you to accept payments via PayPal.

## Request API Credentials - Paypal

API credentials consist of three elements:

- An API username
- An API password
- Either an API signature or an API SSL client-side certificate

If you're using a shopping cart or solution provider, ask whether you need an API signature or a certificate.

- Request API signature** if your shopping cart or solution provider has asked for an API username, password, and signature, or if you're developing a custom shopping cart.
- Request API certificate** if your shopping cart or solution provider requires a file-based certificate.

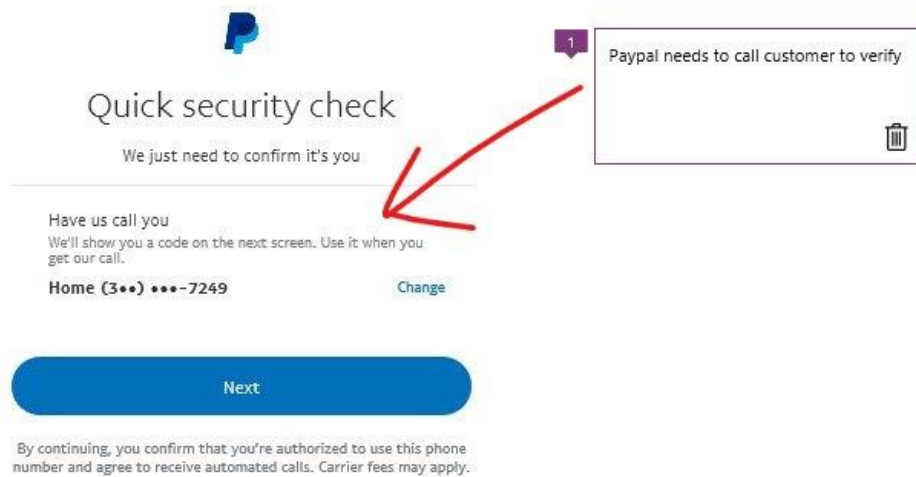
